Relaxing in the landscaped gardens – which embrace the banks of the Llugwy river – you are surrounded by steeply wooded crags which form the gateway to

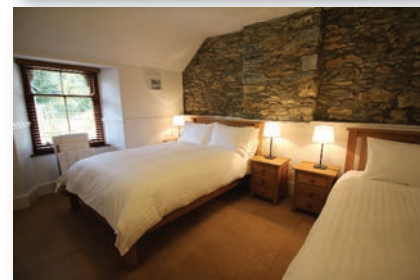

The locality Betws-y-Coed is at the centre of a myriad of outdoor pursuits and activities, including mountaineering, walking, fishing, kyaking, mountain biking, cycling, golf and even surfing. Other interests served include steam and mountain railways, art galleries and of course many of Wales's historic castles and buildings. The village itself has many good shops, bars and restaurants, while St Mary's, the local church, holds musical events – including traditional Welsh male voice choirs. The sea and coast are only 30 minutes' drive away, while the surrounding Snowdonia National Park is outstandingly beautiful.
